Must have a solid foundation

Shouldn't build upper floors until the foundation is set

 Cracks in the foundation put the whole house at risk

Foundation Building Questions



Positioning

- Do I know where the next call is going to happen?
- Do I know who has the best site line for that call?
- Why am I moving?

Communication

- Are my partner and I on the same page?
- Am I practicing preventative officiating?
- Do I have a communication line with the coaches?

Foundation Building Questions



- Rule Knowledge & Interpretations
 - Am I comfortable with my calls?
 - Are my rulings consistent with others whom I respect?
 - Have I set an appropriate standard with my rulings?
- Intangibles
 - Do I ooze "referee"?
 - Am I doing this for the right reasons?
 - Do I protect my integrity?

Build Your Officiating House



Build the solid foundation at the beginning of the season

 Move on to the upper floor gradually once the foundation is set

Continually inspect your house for cracks in the foundation
